<u>Directions</u>: After reading the adventure, discuss the questions below with the listeners.

1. Egypt has been referred to as the "gift of the Nile." What "gifts" did the Nile River have for the people of ancient Egypt?

The Nile provided rich flood waters to irrigate the soil along the river. The Nile also provided fish, papyrus, ducks, and other natural resources.

2. During what season of the year did the people work on the pyramids? Why do you think this was so?

The people of Egypt typically continued the construction of the pyramids during the flood season. This was done because farmers couldn't work in their fields during the flood season. Working on the pyramids provided them with income while their fields were flooded.

3. Did the Nile River hold any dangers? What advice would you give to a fisherman in ancient Egypt?
