SVEA Makes Negotiations Offer to School Board

Cranberry Township, PA – November 6, 2007 – The Seneca Valley Education Association has made an offer to the Seneca Valley School Board that should bring closure to the ongoing labor dispute. (See accompanying letter.) “We’ve listened to the concerns of the community and others and come to the conclusion that it’s time that those elected to represent the community and those elected to represent the SVEA negotiate this dispute to resolution,” said Pat Andrekovich, Negotiations Chairperson of the 580-member SVEA.

“The SVEA sent a letter to Messrs. King and Breth indicating urgency for them to respond,” Andrekovich continued. “No more game-playing, no more PR games, just representatives of the SVEA and the School Board in a room with no outside intervention. No one from Mr. King’s office nor anyone from PSEA will be in attendance. We feel this is the only way this situation will be resolved. The Board members can speak for themselves and we can speak for ourselves.”
